My Responsibilities as a Book Caretaker

- **Keep books in a safe, dry place.** My backpack is a great place to carry my book, but at home, I will keep it on a shelf or a special spot away from pets and babies.
- **Use a bookmark.** I will not fold the corners of the pages (dog-ear them).
- **Return books on time.** I will remember my library day and bring my book back so I can check out a new one.

If a Book is Damaged or Lost

I understand that if I accidentally lose or damage a library book, my family and I will work with the teacher to find a solution. This might mean repairing the book or, in some cases, replacing it so that other students can enjoy it.
